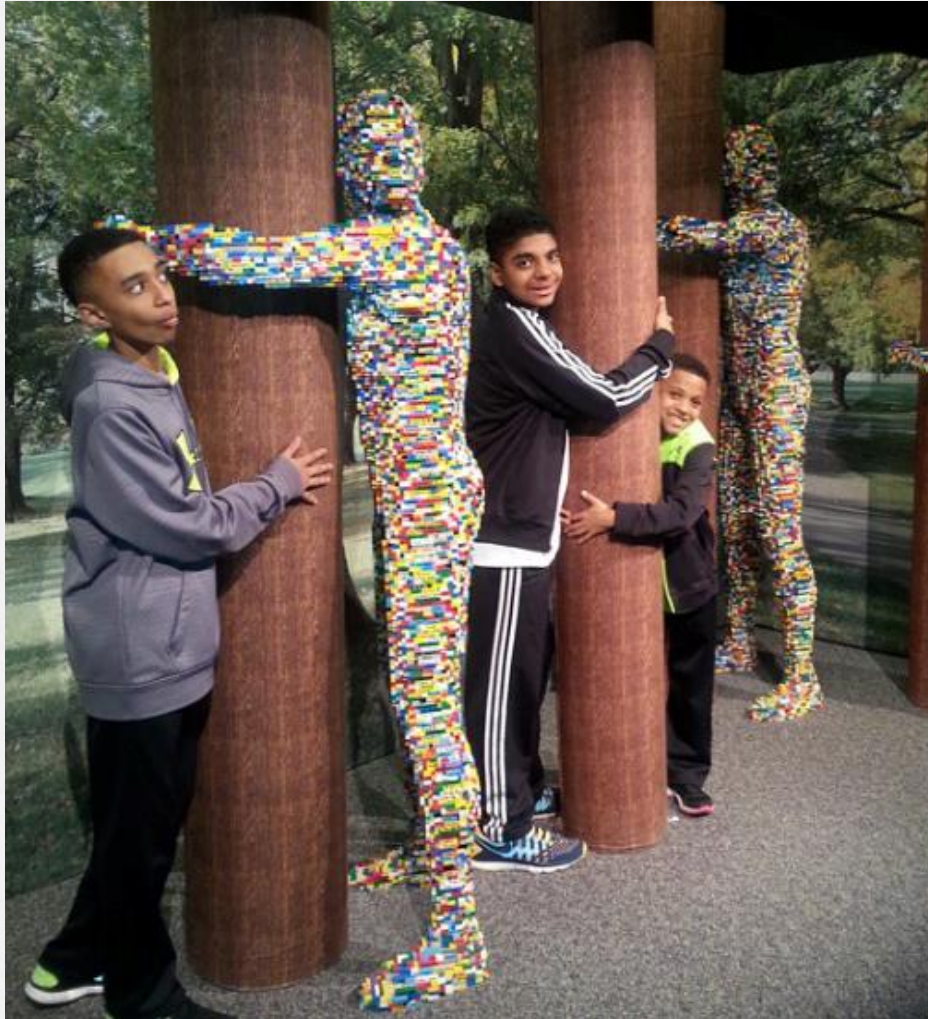
The TV Show
