

Backline:

- (4) Black orchestra style chairs (padded and armless)
- Mics(14), Boom stands(12), DI's(3), Cables, Monitors (See above for detailed list)
- 8'x16' (minimum) Wooden Dance floor (Sprung preferred, Marley is nonoptional)
- (6) Stage Monitor Speakers (5 for musicians and 1 for dancer)

Frontline:

- 24 channel mixing console with house mix and separate monitor mixes.
- Effects unit, preferably high-quality digital hall reverb

Mix notes for this style of music:

- Hall Reverb is required and must be present in both monitors and house.
- Separate monitor mixes for all monitors
- EQ of guitars is essential. Please allow proper time to obtain proper EQ. (lows/mids-10am & highs 1-2pm)
- Background vocals are to mixed at roughly ½ volume of main vocals
