

Tom Bennett is a folk Blues one man band from the North Georgia Countryside His soulful songs are performed on resonator guitar, harmonica, vocals and suitcase bass drum with tambourine, all instruments are played simultaneously.

Tom's story began at 9 years old, growing up on the Eagle Crest Ranch he was given his first harmonica. Many days were spent sitting in the hayfields learning the blues. at age 32 he began playing guitar and was shortly after invited to be the opening act for a nationally touring blues band.

In his twenties Tom hitchhiked, rode greyhound and hitchhiked all over the nation. His hitchhiking led to staying in East L.A. with gangmembers and on another occasion he was surrounded by coyotes while he slept.

Having made his way to Utah, Tom fell in with Mormon Fundamentalists (polygamists) Two years were spent as a Mormon missionary in Wyoming and Northern Utah. He later studied Buddhism and many occult and spiritualist paths.

After sliding into a dark stage, Tom became a cocaine dealer and was arrested, after completing his rehab he became a Boys and Girls Club Director.

He now travels the nation full time performing his songs as selling his unique, handmade jewelry.
