Hayes is a Vietnam era Veteran of the United States Navy serving as a Engineman on the USS Hampshire County LST 819, the USS Thomason LSD 28, and the USS Shreveport LPD 12 from September 1968 through August 1977. A father of seven and married to Maribeth B Catalla of the Philippines.

He is a graduate of the United States Armed Forces School of Music, and has performed as the vocalist with many of America's major military bands such as the Navy Band of the Atlantic Fleet, the Air Force Strategic Air Command Band, and the Air Force Band of the Pacific, and the US Air Force Heartland Of America Band. He has also performed with performers such as Al Harrington, Frank Sinatra Jr., and Frank Mantooth to name a few.

He perform for many Heads of State around the world. Wherever he travels, Maurice Hayes musically crosses cultural barriers, making new friends and entertaining enthusiastic audiences of all nationalities. Whether in recital or as a soloist with orchestras, his praises are enumerated in a many different languages however, they are all in agreement on one point: Maurice Hayes is a major artist and one of America's finest.
