

Michael "Dunigan" DeAngelis started playing Irish Folk Music in Upstate NY's "The Porters" in 1986. A few personnel changes later they became "Hair of the Dog", a band that lasted over 20 years opening for the likes of "The Clancy Brothers", "The Wolfetones", "Black 47", "Tommy Makem", "Great Big Sea", "The Young Wolfetones", "Gaelic Storm" and "Eileen Ivers", among others. After nine Tours of Ireland, Festival appearances in Chicago, Cleveland, Pennsylvania, New York and numerous shows in the Catskills (Irish Alps) as well as their 10+ CD's, Mike and two of his bandmates decided to form "GET UP JACK", who are still performing today. In 2018, Mike relocated (w/his wife Suzie) to Cape Cod, MA and then down to Port St. Lucie, FL, to be closer to family. Mike has concentrated on playing solo shows in Florida, both Irish and Oldies/Country, since moving here in October 2023. Numerous audio/video tracks from "Hair of the Dog", "Get Up Jack" and Mike's two solo cd's are available on Youtube. He continues to make connections with fellow Irish musicians such as Pat Kelleher, Sean & Caroline Brennan, Rose Clancy, Jimmy Kelly (Andy Cooney) & Kevin McKrell. Since moving to Florida, Mike has been playing authentic Irish Pubs as "Michael Dunigan" (using his Mom's Maiden name). These latest gigs have included shows at the "Florida AOH State Convention in Orlando" (this past October 2023), "Tim Finnegan's" -Delray Beach, "Nolan's Irish Pub" - Cocoa Beach and "The Kilted Mermaid" - Vero Beach. He's been invited to perform at "The National AOH Convention" (Orlando) this coming August for both the NY and Florida Associations.

Though much of Mike's work has been Celtic oriented, he's continued to perform music from the 60's-80's, Country, Oldies and Singer-Songwriter oriented tunes throughout his career. At this time, Mike is concentrating on working as a solo artist on Florida's East Coast.
